Section 5 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS (Continued)

The Cooperative shall use reasonable diligence to provide an uninterrupted supply of electric power; however, if such supply shall fail or be interrupted, or shall become inadequate or defective through an act of God, action of the public enemy, accident, strikes, labor troubles, effects of natural elements, inability to secure right-of-way at feasible cost, inability to obtain other permits required, malfunction of equipment, stoppage of power supply to the Cooperative, or for any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Cooperative, then the Cooperative shall not be liable therefore, or for the consequences thereof.

Member agrees to furnish their own protection for any special equipment such as computers (hardware and software), motors, generators, machines, appliances or any other devices or apparatus. Member agrees the Cooperative is not responsible for any damage to member's special equipment, protected or otherwise, due to interruption of service, interruption of one or more phase of service, or any of the conditions outlined on Page 2, Paragraph 5.

If the member is a partnership, organization, limited liability company (LLC), or other legal entity, the member agrees to provide the Cooperative a list of the officers on the member's letterhead, upon request of the Cooperative. Member shall notify the Cooperative of dissolution of the entity or a material change of ownership.

Member agrees to keep the Cooperative informed as to the correct phone number and address of record to which all bills, correspondence and capital credits will be sent. The Cooperative is not liable for errors due to out-of-date member information.

Within 24 business hours of initiating service, it is required that the member call during business hours when they are home, so the Cooperative can operate service disconnect switch on and off to ensure proper connection to residence. If member fails to call in, after 48 hours, the Cooperative will disconnect service until member contacts the Cooperative.

Member does hereby grant and convey to the Cooperative, its successors and assigns, a right to enter upon an easement on, over and upon the member's real property for the purpose of construction, maintenance and operation of the Cooperative's electric system for the benefit of the member and/or other Cooperative members. Member acknowledges that the Cooperative, has the right to freely utilize any platted or dedicated utility easements which now exist or which may be granted or dedicated in the future. Member must not landscape or install improvements which might restrict or inhibit the Cooperative's use of easements. Member agrees that the Cooperative, in the course of operating, constructing, and maintaining its systems, has the right to clear easements of all brush, shrubs, and trees situated therein utilizing mechanical methods or herbicide treatment. The member grants access to the Cooperative's personnel and contractors for purpose of operating, upgrading, maintanining, and constructing facilities, lines, poles, and equipment, including clearing of all easements (utilizing mechanical methods or herbicide treatments) and reading, maintaining and inspecting meter(s) as needed. Member must not enclose meter(s) or block access to meter(s) with buildings, shrubbery, vehicles, fences or other obstacles prohibiting the Cooperative from accessing the meter(s). The National Electric Code (NEC) 110.26 requires adequate working space for all electrical equipment. NEC 110.26 (A) requires a clear space at least 30 inches wide and 36 inches deep if the equipment is likely to be worked on while energized. Member understands and agrees that if the Cooperative must remove any structures, trees, landscaping or any other personal property belonging to the member which interferes with any utility easements granted to the Cooperative and obstructs access to Cooperative infrastructure, the Cooperative is not responsible for any cost associated with the loss of use or replacement of said property.

The member's premises shall be properly wired in accordance with all applicable electric codes. The Cooperative may refuse to connect service and may disconnect power to any service not meeting the codes. This agreement shall continue in full force from the date service is made available by the Cooperative to the member and thereafter until canceled by either party. This agreement shall be binding upon and insure to the benefits of the successors, legal representatives and assignees of the respective parties hereto.		
This agreement is governed by and interpreted under the laws of the state of Kansas.		
Initially, tariff will be assigned to the service. The Cooperative reserves the right to change the tariff if it determines the characteristics of the service do not qualify for the tariff specified. If the characteristics of the service changes, the member shall notify the Cooperative in accordance with the Cooperative's rules and regulations.
