## Section 5 - TERMS AND CONDITIONS

The undersigned (hereinafter called the "member") hereby applies for membership and agrees to purchase electric energy from The Victory Electric Cooperative Association, Inc., (hereinafter called the "Cooperative") in accordance with the terms and conditions described in this agreement.

Upon approval for membership, member agrees to comply with and be bound by all laws and regulations, the Cooperative's articles of incorporation, bylaws, tariffs, and rules and regulations, both as they presently exist or may hereafter be adopted, repealed, amended or supplemented. Member also agrees to obtain electric energy for use on the premises specified in the application.

Member may not install equipment to generate electricity from a source other than the Cooperative without the written consent of the Cooperative.

By providing your cellular phone number, you consent to receive telephone calls and text messages from the Cooperative regarding your service (message frequency varies; message and data rates may apply; text STOP to opt out, HELP for assistance) and agree to our Privacy Policy <https://victoryelectric.net/privacy-policy>.

Service may be terminated by the Cooperative at the request of member or in accordance with policies, rules and regulations adopted by the Cooperative board of trustees, or in accordance with orders, directives or rules and regulations of governmental bodies. Service shall be provided in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Cooperative. Disconnection of service for non-payment in no way relieves the member from obligations under the terms of this or other agreements between the member and the Cooperative.

The member shall pay the Cooperative for service hereunder at the rates and upon the terms and conditions set forth in the tariff schedule appropriate for the service requested. Service will be subject to a minimum monthly bill according to the characteristics of the service. By signing this application, the applicant gives the Cooperative permission to run a soft utility credit check for the purpose of setting deposit requirements, if necessary. Businesses agree to a Business ID validation check through Online Utility Exchange. Members who do not meet the Cooperative's credit requirements are required to pay a deposit. Reference the appropriate tariff schedule at [victoryelectric.net](http://victoryelectric.net) for details.

A deposit of \$ 0 is required.

Payments shall be in accordance with the rules and regulations of the Cooperative. If the member fails to pay service bills by the due date, the Cooperative may disconnect service.

The member agrees if, at any time, the rate is revised by the Cooperative board of trustees, the new rate will apply.

The Cooperative shall use reasonable diligence to provide an uninterrupted supply of electric power; however, if such supply shall fail or be interrupted, or shall become inadequate or defective through an act of God, action of the public enemy, accident, strikes, labor troubles, effects of natural elements, inability to secure right-of-way at feasible cost, inability to obtain other permits required, malfunction of equipment, stoppage of power supply to the Cooperative, or for any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Cooperative, then the Cooperative shall not be liable therefore, or for the consequences thereof.

Member agrees to furnish their own protection for any special equipment such as computers (hardware and software), motors, generators, machines, appliances or any other devices or apparatus. Member agrees the Cooperative is not responsible for any damage to member's special equipment, protected or otherwise, due to interruption of service, interruption of one or more phase of service, or any of the conditions outlined on Page 2, Paragraph 5.

If the member is a partnership, organization, limited liability company (LLC), or other legal entity, the member agrees to provide the Cooperative a list of the officers on the member's letterhead, upon request of the Cooperative. Member shall notify the Cooperative of dissolution of the entity or a material change of ownership.

Member agrees to keep the Cooperative informed as to the correct phone number and address of record to which all bills, correspondence and capital credits will be sent. The Cooperative is not liable for errors due to out-of-date member information.

Within 48 business hours of initiating service, it is required that the member call during business hours when they are home, so the Cooperative can operate service disconnect switch on and off to ensure proper connection to residence. If member fails to call in, after 48 hours, the Cooperative will disconnect service until member contacts the Cooperative.

Member must not landscape or install improvements which might restrict or inhibit the Cooperative's use of easements. Member agrees that the Cooperative, in the course of operating, constructing, and maintaining its systems, has the right to clear easements of all brush, shrubs, and trees situated therein utilizing mechanical methods or herbicide treatment. The member grants access to the Cooperative's personnel and contractors for purpose of operating, upgrading, maintaining, and constructing facilities, lines, poles, and equipment, including clearing of all easements (utilizing mechanical methods or herbicide treatments) and reading, maintaining and inspecting meter(s) as needed. Member must not enclose meter(s) or block access to meter(s) with buildings, shrubbery, vehicles, fences or other obstacles prohibiting the Cooperative from accessing the meter(s). The National Electric Code (NEC) 110.26 requires adequate working space for all electrical equipment. NEC 110.26 (A) requires a clear space at least 30 inches wide and 36 inches deep if the equipment is likely to be worked on while energized. Member understands and agrees that if the Cooperative must remove any structures, trees, landscaping or any other personal property belonging to the member which interferes with any utility easements granted to the Cooperative and obstructs access to Cooperative infrastructure, the Cooperative is not responsible for any cost associated with the loss of use or replacement of said property.

Member shall notify the cooperative of dissolution of the entity or a material change of ownership.

Member must not enclose meters or block access to meters with buildings, shrubbery, vehicles, fences or other obstacles prohibiting the cooperative from accessing the meters.

The member's premises shall be properly wired in accordance with all applicable electric codes. The cooperative may refuse to connect service and may disconnect power to any service not meeting the codes. This agreement shall continue in full force from the date service is made available by the cooperative to the member and thereafter until canceled by either party. This agreement shall be binding upon and ensure to the benefits of the successors, legal representatives and assigns of the respective parties hereto.

This agreement is governed by and interpreted under the laws of the state of Kansas.

Initially, tariff will be assigned to the service. The cooperative reserves the right to change the tariff if it determines the characteristics of the service do not qualify for the tariff specified. If the characteristics of the service changes, the member shall notify the cooperative in accordance with the cooperative's rules and regulations.

***Within 48 business hours of initiating service, it is required that the member call during business hours when they are home, so the Cooperative can operate service disconnect switch on and off to ensure proper connection to residence. If member fails to call in, after 48 hours, the Cooperative will disconnect service until member contacts the Cooperative.***
